114 Mobile Control and Reporting Unit, based in RAAF DARWIN, provides the ADF with a deployable Aerospace Battle Management capability. The Unit has a proud history, and is the only non-flying RAAF unit to have a Squadron Standard.

114MCRU's tasks include the provision of Air Defence of a Mobile Sector, and a Tactical Air Operations Centre in support of DJFHQ objectives. Equipped with the TPS-43 Mobile Radar and support cabins, 114MCRU regularly deploy on training exercises such as PITCH BLACK, CROCODILE, ACES NORTH and TASMAN LINK, with many exercises involving joint operations with foreign military forces such as the USA, UK, Canada and New Zealand.

Whilst in garrison at RAAF Darwin, 114MCRU provides tactical fighter control to the F/A-18 Hornets of 75SQN, and conducts local area surveillance of the northern region.
