



## **Surveillance and Control Training Unit**

Surveillance and Control Training Unit (SACTU) was formed at Williamtown on 9 August 1999. The Unit conducts basic and post graduate training for Air Defence Officers and Air Surveillance Operators, as well as specialist technical training for technicians employed within 41Wing.

The Unit consists of four sections, Air Defence Training, Air Surveillance Training, Technician Training and Training Development. The Unit conducts four Air Defence Controller and four Air Surveillance Operator courses per year. Air Defence Officer return to SACTU throughout their careers to undertake various levels of post-graduate training.

In addition to Air Defence and Air Surveillance training, SACTU conducts around 20 technical training courses per year providing the necessary skills and knowledge to maintain equipment within 41 Wing.
